



District Goals

1. To increase our graduation rate to above 90 percent, and to decrease our drop-out rate to less than 5 percent.
2. To exceed the state average on all ELA and math assessments in grades 3 through 8, and to increase proficiency rates by 10 percent.
3. To improve student proficiency rates on each Regent's exam to rank in the top 5 of the Broome-Tioga BOCES region, as well as to show growth in mastery.
4. To achieve 85 percent of students reading at or above grade level, and to show 20 percent annual growth on writing benchmarks in grades Pre-K through 8.
5. To attain an 85 percent participation in school/community programs amongst students in grades 3 through 12.
