- Non-graduates must have made a significant contribution to the school community (this is defined as any contribution **beyond contractual obligation** that has strengthened the school district's capability to provide a high-quality education to the Owego Apalachin students.)
- The nominee has demonstrated service in the community in which they live or have lived.
- The nominee has displayed exemplary achievement in the nominee's area of specialization.
- The nominee has received recognition, honors, and awards at the local, state, national, or international level.
