

Dear Owego Apalachin School Community,

Beginning tomorrow, Friday, November 13th and running through Tuesday, November 24th, ALL OACSD students will transition to 100% fully remote instruction. This learning model change is for ALL buildings - OES, AES, OAMS and OFA. *(No Instruction or School for Thanksgiving Break: Wednesday, November 25th - Friday, November 27th)* At this time, In-person/Hybrid Instruction is scheduled to resume on Monday, November 30th.

- Class Zoom link(s) and the daily schedule are available on your child's learning platform (Google Classroom or Schoology) as communicated by your child's teacher. If you are uncertain where this information is, I encourage you to reach out to your child's teacher for clarification and details.
- Students at all grade levels will follow their daily schedule to continue to receive live instruction. (This may look different based on grade level, but the students will be engaged in school during their regularly scheduled school day.)
- Attendance will continue to be taken daily and instruction, class work, and grading will continue.
- Special Education and Related Services will be provided virtually.
- Operation of BOCES programs will differ depending on the program, location and the status of Broome - Tioga BOCES in general. This will be communicated to those affected.

During the time of full remote instruction, meals will be provided for students who request them. Please email Sandy Phillips at phillipss@oacsd.org to request meals. Families who already receive home delivery of meals, will continue to do so.

- All after school activities, including athletic practices, are canceled during this time period.
- School Pictures will be rescheduled for a later date.

The health and safety of our students, staff, families, and the entire community are always a priority behind decisions like these. We are all aware of the current COVID-19 numbers locally and in surrounding communities. We continue to ask for the assistance and support of everyone in our community to help decrease the number of positive COVID-19 cases in our district and county. We encourage everyone to think carefully about and remain vigilant with regard to distancing, mask wearing, unnecessary gatherings and contacts, monitoring symptoms, and observing good respiratory and hand hygiene.
